

Provisional National Assessments 2022

Despite the challenges over the last 2 years, our children and staff have been working fantastically hard and we are delighted with their achievements. Our Reception, Year One, Year Two and Year Six children have been assessed, along with all the children in the country in the same years. Attached are provisional summaries of how well our school has achieved in each of those assessments. The comparisons, with local and national school figures, are based on the information we have currently available. There are a few caveats to this data:

- 1) National data for EYFSP, Phonics and KS1 is based on around 148 LA's data – this should be fairly robust but always a chance of a small change.
- 2) The KS2 progress is based on the 2019 DfE model – we will not know until later in September if DfE will tweak this, so there may be minor changes.
- 3) National data for KS2 is based on 132 LA's. Given the issues with processing some of the SAT results, there is a chance that there may be some movement in these results. These to be no more than 1%+/- on threshold measures. There is also potential that this might impact on the progress scores slightly.
- 4) The KS2 data assumes that the higher score will remain at 110 –this is yet to be confirmed.

We know these results are based on strong partnerships between school and home, and the expertise of our staff and our Governing Body, and thank everyone for their commitment to our school.

Progress scores are presented as positive and negative numbers either side of zero. A score of 0 would mean pupils in this school, on average, do about as well at Key Stage 2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally. A positive score means on average more progress than similar pupils nationally and a negative score means on average less progress than similar pupils nationally.
