Dear Parents,

It has been lovely to welcome back the children to St George and St Teresa and listen to their stories of their summer.

It has been wonderful to see lots of learning happening around school this week and hearing the children articulating what it is they're learning. Over the next couple of months we will be making changes to some structure and routines of the school.
