It has been another busy week at school! Thank you to all those who attended the 'meet the leaders' meeting last night. I hope you found it useful and can see our vision for the school, it has been lovely to hear all the positive comments and thank you for being so supportive. There were a few suggestions for feedback and these will be actioned over the next week. If you would like to discuss anything else please contact the office to arrange a meeting.

We have received communication from local neighbours who have had parents parking on their drives or blocking their access. Please could you be mindful where you park and obey the parking restrictions in place.

Today you will receive a retrieval task. This is the school's new approach to homework this year. Our curriculum is knowledge enriched and we have a focus on the children's retrieval of this knowledge. You will be sent fortnightly a retrieval sheet which will focus on prior learning from the last two weeks in school. These will be texted to you either on a Friday/Monday and there will also be a copy in their bag on a Friday. We would expect the homework to be back in school the following Friday. The dates will be on the retrieval task for you. Most children will be able to complete this independently.

As discussed at the meeting we will be implementing a new behaviour scheme with clear routines and structure. Once the policy has been ratified with governors this will be shared with yourselves so you will be aware of the structure that we will be consistently following as a school.

Thank you for the donations of board games so far, we are creating zones at break time to allow children to access a range of activities to keep them active and entertained during their break and lunchtimes.

Mrs Butcher who is the new SENDco for the school will be holding a SENDco surgery on Thursday 28th September at 9.15am. A letter will be following with more details.
