<b>Phonics and Early reading scheme to be evaluated for its effectiveness.</b>	Monitoring by SLT, the MAC and Read Write Inc. has begun and will continue over the next term to help determine the effectiveness of early reading and phonics.	By the end of the Autumn 2.
<b>New KS2 and KS1 (when children are fluent readers) reading scheme—accelerated reader.</b>	The new scheme will be introduced to children in school and families will receive a letter introducing the scheme explaining how it works and the positive impact it will have on attainment, challenge and progress.	By October half term dependent on delivery of books.
<b>For the curriculum journey of every child in school to be explicit, detailed and shared with all stakeholders.</b>	Through knowledge organisers for all children. Adaptive learning used for children with additional needs and this to be shared with parents.	Autumn 2
<b>For the behaviour policy to be reviewed and shared with all stakeholders.</b>	Through a behaviour scheme, Going for Gold, positive behaviour will be the focus. When there is unacceptable behaviour this will be dealt through a staged approach which will be used across all year groups leading to consistency of behaviour.	By October half term.
