This will involve learning about those less fortunate than ourselves and doing what we can to help them. We have chosen two charities to support this year, Father Hudson's and Mary's Meals. Speakers from both will be in school to tell the children about who they help and how we can support.



There will be lots of lent-based activities including a coin cross constructed from the money in the Father Hudson's envelopes, modernised Stations of the Cross and a cake sale.

Father John visited Year 6 last week for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Afterwards, he spent more time with Year 6 teaching them to be champions for Reconciliation in our school. They are going to work with Years 4 and 5 to help prepare them for Reconciliation with Father John in a couple of weeks time.


