## **Reduction to Published Admission Number – St George and St Teresa’s Catholic Primary School**

Our Lady and All Saints Multi Academy Company is consulting on the 2027/28 admission number (PAN) for St George and St Teresa’s Catholic Primary School. The school currently operates an admission number of 30, and this would seek a reduction to 15.

At the request of Directors, the proposed reduction in PAN was considered and approved by the Local Governing Board on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2025, following a drop in applications in recent years and the forecast intake for the school for future years. By applying for a reduction in PAN, the school will be able to better financially plan for the reduction in pupil numbers which will minimise the disruption to teaching and learning at the school.

Even with a reduction of the PAN to 15, we would expect the school to be able to accommodate all the children living in its catchment area that apply for a place and siblings of children already at the school, at its normal point of intake.

This change in PAN is due to a fall in the birth rate in Solihull and therefore a reduction in families applying for a reception place.

As part of the process, the MAC is required to notify Parents, all admission authorities in the area and all local schools. 
